

TRANSFER STUDENTS

I've been admitted to UT! **what's next?**

step one: **Activate your UT e-mail account.**

- Receive a letter with your student ID & NetID from the Registrar's Office.
- Go to oit.utk.edu/lifep to learn how to set up and activate your free UT e-mail account.
- Send friends and family e-mails to tell them that you will be attending UT.
- Receive important updates from UT about Housing, Orientation, Financial Aid, and much more.

step two: **Receive your transfer credit evaluation.**

- Your transfer credit evaluation will be posted online at the time the course timetable for your entry term is available (summer, mid-February; fall, mid-March; spring, mid-October).
- To view your transfer credit evaluation, go to MyUtk.utk.edu and log on using your UT NetID and password.
- At orientation, your advisor will have access to your transfer credit evaluation to assist you in course selection and registration.

step three: **Register for student orientation.**

- All new students are required to attend Orientation, and special sessions are held throughout the year for transfer students. Review the dates for transfer orientation at sold.utk.edu/dates.php, and register for a session prior to your term of enrollment at sold.utk.edu/register.php.
- During Orientation, you will be advised and register for classes. You can review the course catalog at catalog.utk.edu. Before the beginning of each academic term, you can view semester class offerings and schedules in the online timetable at registrar.tennessee.edu/timetable.

step four: **Learn about financial aid.**

- Submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) each year at www.fafsa.ed.gov. UT's federal code is 003530. Submit the FAFSA by February 15 to be considered for the widest range of federal and state aid.
- If you have been admitted for the spring or summer term, update your previously filed FAFSA to include UT Knoxville as your first-choice college/university.

- UT offers several academic scholarships to transfer students. Apply by April 1, with the Continuing & Transfer Scholarship Application, available at finaid.utk.edu/apply/transfer.shtml.

step five: **Arrange your housing & dining.**

- UT offers a wide range of housing options for transfer students who wish to have the convenience of living on campus. Visit uthousing.utk.edu to learn about your options.
- A housing contract will be sent to your UT e-mail account, or you may contract for campus housing/dining and indicate your living and dining preferences, click on the "My Housing" link at uthousing.utk.edu. Confirmed contracts cannot be cancelled unless you do not enroll.



important dates TO REMEMBER

January: Begin completing the *Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)* to apply for financial aid. The form is available on the Web at www.fafsa.ed.gov. Tennessee Educational Lottery Scholarships require the FAFSA. For more information, visit www.tn.gov/collegepays.

February 15: Submit your completed FAFSA online no later than this date.

April 1: Deadline to apply for transfer scholarships. Visit finaid.utk.edu/apply/transfer.shtml.
