#### NOVEMBER 15: EARLY ACTION COMPLETION DEADLINE

In order to receive a decision in mid-December, you must complete your SRAR by this date.

#### NOVEMBER 22: UNIVERSITY HONORS APPLICATION (ESSAY) DEADLINE

Invited students must submit their essay by this date to be fully eligible for University Honors programs.

#### DECEMBER 15: REGULAR ADMISSION APPLICATION DEADLINE

Apply by this date for regular admission and to be considered for institutional scholarships, like the Volunteer Scholarship.
