STANDARDIZED TEST SCORES

We use the superscoring method, meaning we take your highest section scores of each test to determine your new composite score for application review. In order to be fully considered for institutional scholarships, tests must be received prior to July 1 at the end of your senior year.

SELF-REPORTED ACADEMIC RECORD (SRAR)





NOVEMBER 15: EARLY ACTION COMPLETION DEADLINE

To receive a decision in December, you must complete your SRAR by this date.

NOVEMBER 20: UNIVERSITY HONORS APPLICATION (ESSAY) DEADLINE

Invited students must submit their essay by this date to be fully eligible for University Honors programs.

DECEMBER 16: REGULAR ADMISSION APPLICATION DEADLINE

Apply by this date for regular admission and to be fully considered for institutional scholarships, like the Volunteer Scholarship.

JANUARY 17: REGULAR APPLICATION COMPLETION DEADLINE

In order to receive a decision in March, you must complete your SRAR by this date.

MAY 1: CONFIRMATION DEADLINE

New Vols must confirm their enrollment to UT by May 1.

JULY 1: OFFICIAL DOCUMENTS DUE

UT must receive your official documents by July 1 to finalize admission and any financial aid and scholarships that may have been offered to you.
