APPLICATION REVIEW

UT has a competitive but holistic admissions process. We consider your experience and preparation in academic areas as well as other factors including:

- Rigor of your high school curriculum
- Difficulty of senior-level coursework

- Job and volunteer experience
- Awards
- Special talents or skills
- ACT/SAT Test Scores
- Optional supporting statement

STANDARDIZED TEST SCORES

We use the superscoring method, meaning we take your highest section scores of each test to determine your new composite score for application review. In order to be fully considered for institutional scholarships, tests must be received prior to July 1 at the end of your senior year.

SELF-REPORTED ACADEMIC RECORD (SRAR)

UT requires prospective students to self-report their unofficial high school transcripts, grades, and standardized test scores. Applicants must complete the SRAR in order for their application to be reviewed. Final grades will be confirmed prior to enrollment.

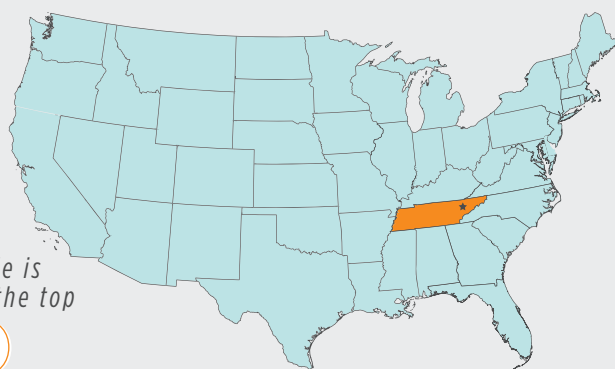

IMPORTANT DATES

NOVEMBER 1: EARLY ACTION ADMISSION DEADLINE

Apply by this date to be fully considered for competitive and institutional scholarships and University Honors programs.

NOVEMBER 15: EARLY ACTION COMPLETION DEADLINE

To receive a decision in December, you must complete your SRAR by this date.

NOVEMBER 20: UNIVERSITY HONORS APPLICATION (ESSAY) DEADLINE

Invited students must submit their essay by this date to be fully eligible for University Honors programs.

DECEMBER 16: REGULAR ADMISSION APPLICATION DEADLINE

Apply by this date for regular admission and to be fully considered for institutional scholarships, like the Volunteer Scholarship.

JANUARY 17: REGULAR APPLICATION COMPLETION DEADLINE

In order to receive a decision in March, you must complete your SRAR by this date.

MAY 1: CONFIRMATION DEADLINE

New Vols must confirm their enrollment to UT by May 1.

JULY 1: OFFICIAL DOCUMENTS DUE

UT must receive your official documents by July 1 to finalize admission and any financial aid and scholarships that may have been offered to you.
